BRIEF NOTES FROM THE SHOW/PRECISION MEETING
MATOSINHOS, PORTUGAL 30.4.2016

PRESENT:

Estonia, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain

Non-attendance by Andorra and Israel.

The President apologised to all Delegates regarding the cancellations of training due to the condition of the floor, and said that all training have been re-scheduled for early the next morning, and that the Technicians controlling the condition of the floor had worked all night to prepare it better for the Championships. Unfortunately even the technicians could not explain why the condition of the floor changed as it had been used on many occasions previously for Artistic Competitions and this had never happened.

She explained that all had been included in the new training schedule, but this would mean a very late finish in the first evening, because many floor cleaning schedules will be taking place during all events. The whole situation had caused great distress to the Organisers, and also it had caused them extra costs as the floor was completely re-surfaced over night.

All Delegates understood but were anxious that this should never happen again, and that CERS Artistic Technical Committee must ensure that the surface was always totally checked in the future. She assured all that this had been the case here in Matosinhos this year, but would ensure this for the future, and thanked all the Nations for their understanding of the problem.

Future Championships

There was a great deal of discussion about the future countries who wish to stage these European Championships, and attached is the updated Calendar for all.

New Business

The Delegate from Italy gave the following proposal and asked for the Nations opinion on Junior Precision :-

They suggest the number of skaters for Junior Precision is reduced from 16-24 to 12-16 skaters because they feel that this may help smaller countries compete in Junior Precision with less skaters.

They also suggest that the elements for Junior Precision are reduced and would put forward to CERS ATC a suggestions if the Nations present thought this a good solution.

All countries present agreed with both suggestions, and Italy was asked to send urgently, their official proposal to CERS ATC, so that information can go out quickly to all Nations, as the Delegate from France stated that now the Championships are over, many countries and their Clubs will start working on their programmes for 2017.

Italy agreed to do this urgently, and the President said the information would be sent out as soon as possible to all European Nations.

The President thanked all Delegates present and wished them all the very best of luck
